

## **Hayden Avenue**

### **Huetter Corridor to US-95 (widen to 3-lanes)**

Overview: As growth continues across the Rathdrum Prairie, the City of Hayden continues to see increased demand to improve Hayden Avenue. Since it provides access to Ramsey Road, the Huetter Corridor, State Highway 41 (SH-41) and US-95, it plays an important role in providing regional access to the transportation system. Additionally, increased development along this corridor will further the demand for reconstructing this east/west arterial across the Rathdrum Prairie.

Description: Reconstruct Hayden Avenue from the Huetter Corridor to US-95.

Financial Strategy: Hayden Avenue is currently classified as an Urban Minor arterial, which means it has limited opportunities for Federal participation, and no participation by ITD. Hayden Avenue is eligible for one grant program with selected projects that are programmed out through 2027. To meet the objective of reconstructing this facility in a timely manner to address existing deficiencies and emerging residential, business, and light industrial growth, significant regional/local financial contributions will be necessary. As a local road, the Local Option funds would provide additional funds to advance the project. The use of Federal funds is highly unlikely, as those program funds are in high demand and projects have already been identified.
