

Poleline Avenue

Huetter Corridor to SH-41 (widen to 5-lanes)

Overview: The City of Coeur d'Alene and the City of Post Falls have experienced explosive growth between the two communities. Poleline Avenue is the only east/west roadway south of Prairie Avenue and north of Interstate 90 (I-90) between State Highway 41 and Huetter Road. As a result, residential and commercial traffic will continue to rely more on Poleline Avenue to make east/west trips. It is anticipated that, with the recent acquisition of a large land parcel between Huetter and Meyer Roads south of Poleline Avenue and the upcoming development of land between Huetter Road and Atlas Road, the short segment of roadway between Huetter Road and Carrington Lane will be constructed. This will complete the Poleline Avenue/Hanley Avenue connection and create a new east/west route just north of I-90 from Government Way to Pleasant View Road, which is currently only served by Prairie Avenue.

Description: Reconstruct Poleline Avenue to current 5-lane design standards from SH-41 to the Huetter Corridor.

Financial Strategy: Being a local arterial, Poleline Avenue has only one (1) Federal aid program from which to apply for funds. This means it has limited opportunities for Federal participation and no participation by ITD through State and/or Federal formula funding. As a local arterial with regional significance, the Local Option funds would provide additional Local funds to advance the project.
